2. Overview of the Depot planning status

Miko reviewed the KY Depot website and discussed the Depot Budget Summary & Timeline document from the Business Plan Work Team with the members. SREB has purchased 19 math and science objects on our behalf. Betsy will be working on importing those objects into our sandbox. The Business Plan team decided to allow assets as well as objects. Miko also described the differences between federation and harvesting learning objects and explained that the Business Plan team will decide who to federate with and who to harvest.

3. How to design the Depot training plan

The training team discussed who should be trained and who the target audience should be. Miko explained that KY has two SREB membership (one through CPE and one through KDE) so we are entitled to two training sessions. The group felt that the emphasis should be on training trainers from K12 and higher education.

4. Review the SCORE training content and schedule

The training team referred to and discussed the SCORE training options and decided that Option A should be used for both training session if Linda Pittenger agrees. Option A allows 20 participants for the first day and 15 participants the second day for the hands-on training. The preferred dates for the first training were either May 14 & 15 or May 28 & 29. The preferred dates for the second training were April 16-18 or April 28-30. Sarah will check with KCTCS regarding using the computer training lab at the system office on these dates and Bill Wade will check with Elizabethtown regarding the availability of their training room. Miko will check with Linda regarding the training option selection and these dates. Then, Miko will schedule the trainings with SREB. After the dates are set, Miko will communicate with the other depot teams regarding who they want to recommend to participate in the training.

5. Meetings

Our next meeting will be the Monday following the first training (either April 21 or May 5) to further discuss and develop the training plan.
